Other Ways to Make a Difference:

Gateway Shelter for victims of domestic violence

- Victim support at the hospital during sexual assault nurse exams (SANE) (requires training)
- Case Management Assistance (talking with residents to help them identify their greatest needs and encouraging them to enroll in appropriate YWCA programs or other community support programs to obtain no-cost assistance such as skills training, legal support for civil legal matters, addiction counseling, financial counseling, etc.)
- Childcare (watching Gateway residents' children for an allotted amount of time while Gateway residents to conduct errands or go to appointments, or to simply have some mom self-care!)
- Crafts and activities for Gateway children
- Translator
- Pet foster caregiver for Gateway residents' pets
- Meal preparation
- Donation sorting
- Housekeeping

Child Care and Learning Center

- Substitute teachers and providers (Works under supervision of Child Center Coordinator and requires immunizations and training for license compliance)
- Organizing special activities and learning modules (works under supervision of Child Center Coordinator and requires immunizations and training for license compliance)
